While teachers are finalising their marks, we haven't got our overall results for Term 1, but I know from class visits and talking to teachers we are on track to achieving our Term 1 goals.

Congratulations to our parents/carers and students for the pleasing improvement in attendance. We ended 2023 on 86% attendance, which is quite low compared to like schools. Our goal for Term 1 is 91% At the time of writing the newsletter we had reached 90.4% SO CLOSE!!!


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
